RCIA

A Foundation for Faith

Classes will begin in October.

If you know someone who would like to inquire into the Catholic faith or someone who has been away from the Church who would like to return, please contact Ashley See in the parish office.

What is RCIA?

RCIA is a formal program of religious education, prayer, spirituality, and liturgy whereby adults are formally received into the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist.

What you can tell people when inviting them to attend RCIA classes:

The first step is inquiry. This is the period of time* for a group of individuals to meet with the RCIA leader to learn about, ask questions, and understand and experience the teachings and practices of the Catholic Church, to consider what God is saying to them in the Scriptures, to search one's spiritual heart, and to consider his or her personal relationship with Jesus.

After this period of inquiry, the individual will determine if they want to elect to receive the Sacraments.

The group of inquirers may include:

- those who have never been baptized,
- those who are already baptized Christians,
- those who have received First Holy Eucharist in the Catholic Church and are seeking to be confirmed in the Catholic faith.

**Along with attending Mass, there is one meeting 1-hour per week for approximately six months.*

Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time Weekend of August 24/25, 2019

The Gospel reading today starts with a question: "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" Jesus offers only a simple reply: Strive to enter through the narrow gate. Many will try to enter and will not be able. Good stewards know there is only one, narrow gate. Not everything will fit. This narrow gate has no room for our accomplishments. No room for our money. No room for our possessions. No room for anything else but those who've been good stewards of the Gospel. We can't custom build our own gates either. There is only one, narrow gate that happens to be open for a time, but for how long? What is our plan of action to get through that gate?
